## JICA officials visits PMU Office, Project sites in Tseminyu & Wokha



Officials from Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA), Shri. Ikko Watanabe, First Secretary (Food & Agriculture) Economic Section, Embassy of Japan in India, Shri. Vineet S. Sarin, Chief Development Specialist, JICA India Office, New Delhi and Shri. Hidenobu Fujiwara, Representative, JICA India Office, New Delhi visited the Office of the Project Management Unit (PMU), NFMP at the Forest Office Complex, Kohima on 1<sup>st</sup> June 2022 and held discussions with the Officials of the NFMP. Prior to discussion with the NFMP Officials, Shri. Ikko Watanabe inaugurated the SHG stall of various DMUs being set up in the PMU Office. On the 2<sup>nd</sup> day, the Officials from JICA, laid the foundation stone for Terogvunyu village gate on 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2022, which is being constructed as an entry point activity under the Nagaland Forest Management Project (NFMP). The visiting officials also planted cherry saplings near the proposed site of the village gate.

During a brief interaction with the village community, the JICA officials said that NFMP is a community project and encouraged the village community to work together for the benefit of the future.

The team also visited Longsachung village under DMU Wokha and inspected the nursery site, Jhum Agro Forestry (JAF) Model and had interactions with various stakeholders. SHGs from Batch-I villages displayed their IGA products which was initiated through the Revolving Fund provided under the NFMP-JICA. The visiting team inspected the Office Building, Officer and Staff Quarters in forest colony, Wokhawich was constructed under the project.

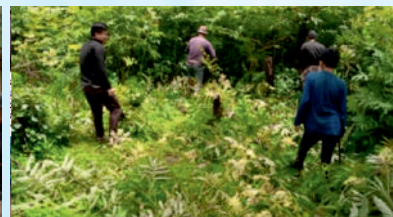

JFMC Members from Batch-I & II villages, Community Mobilizers of Batch-I, II & III villages attended the Annual Review Meeting.

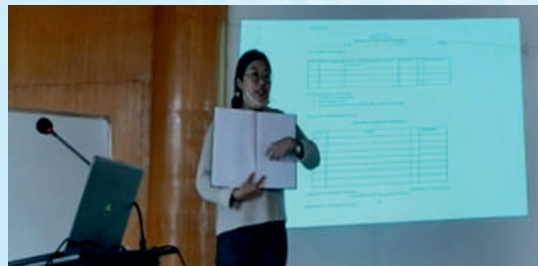
**Trainings on Orientation of NFMP, JFMC Constitution & Management and JFMC Record Keeping & Financial Management:**

Development activities that were in conformity to the project guidelines along with fund allotment were shared in the meeting. The meeting was concluded by taking the JFMC executives to the range nursery where demonstration on poly packing, sowing techniques and maintenance was shown by the Mali staff.

**PMC visit Mongsenyimti (Batch-I Village):** Project Management Consultants, Shri. Pravanjan and Shri. Devanshu (Livelihood Expert) visited Mongsenyimti village on 4<sup>th</sup> June 2022. They visited the JAF model and interacted with the JFMC members. The villagers briefed them on the species selected for this model, saplings distributed and the work carried out. They also checked the record maintenance of the SHGs and JFMC and conveyed the JFMCs to be detailed with the voluntary contributions made from their end and to improve upon recording the activities for assessment purpose.

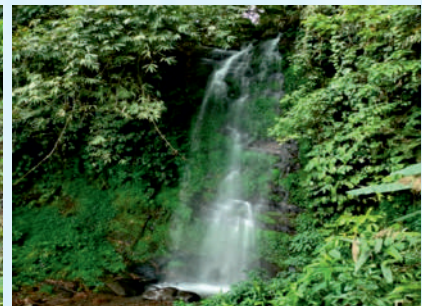
