The quarter witnessed various activities under NFMP including nursery maintenance, plantation maintenance, trainings and field visits.

DMU Dimapur:

- * FMU Head Shri. Bendangtemsu, DMU support staffs and FNGO members visited Thekrejuma village (Batch-I) on 18th Oct 2023, to conduct meeting with JFMC and SHGs members. During the meeting, the visiting team briefed the members on various issues regarding the formation of SHG clusters from the existing SHGs for the village.
- * DMU Dimapur celebrated the Wildlife Week on 2nd Oct. 2023. While observing the wildlife week, a team of 15 professionals under Mobius Young Climate Leaders for Himalayan Development were briefed and trained on all aspects of Wildlife including awareness, conservation, human-animal conflict issues, Wildlife Protection Act 1972, Nagaland scenario of wildlife conservation and protection via Community Conservation Areas; the importance of wildlife awareness among children and let the children be a source of creating more awareness in their families, friends and neighbours; to influence children to be an agent and also be enthusiasts for wildlife and nature in future. From 4th–6th Oct. 2023, Mobius team toured and covered 15 schools across Chumukedima, Niuland and Dimapur district under Dimapur Forest Division observing wildlife week, creating awareness, motivating and influencing thousands of students from the schools.



* In Ruzaphema Village - the villagers are raising the saplings at their respective homes; every household is committed to raise 1000 saplings which will later be shifted to the NFMP nursery for further care and plantation. Approximately 2791 saplings is being raised, consisting of species such as Khokon, Neem, Kothal, Betelnut etc.





- * FMU Head Shri. Bendangtemsu, FMU Staffs and FNGO members visited Ruzaphema village (Batch-III) on 7th Nov. 2023 to conduct a meeting with JFMC members. The team conveyed the JFMC members about the guidelines to be followed during the implementation of various works under forestry intervention models and nursery techniques to be adopted for raising healthy seedlings, maintenance of good nursery stock for the next year plantation. The team also visited Sirhi Angami village (Batch-III) to conduct meeting with JFMC and SHGs members. JFMC Nursery site and the saplings raised by individual households were inspected and proper instructions on preparation of good nursery soils and selection of species as per the different FIMs were discussed during the meeting.
- * FMU Head Shri. Bendangtemsu, DMU support staffs, FMU staffs and FNGO team visited Pherima-A village (Batch-II) on 9th Nov. 2023, to conduct a meeting with JFMC members and SHGs. During the meeting, the team gave certificates to JFMC and SHG members who participated in the "Meri Maati Meri Desh" campaign. The members discussed on the formation of SHG cluster at the village level and decided to complete the remaining work on GIS Mobile mapping for all the FIMs.
- * Shri. Sandeep Rajgotra, IFS and Shri Ganesan, IFS (both attached officers) and FNGO staffs visited Sirhi Angami village (Batch-III) and Piphema Old village (Batch-II) on 22nd Nov. 2023. The officers examined all the record books maintained at the JFMC level of each village, conveyed the instructions on proper maintenance of Nursery sapling stocks and inspected the nursery sites.

Seed distribution: Under the Convergence programme with District Agricultural Office, Department of Agriculture Kohima, vegetable seeds comprising of peas, beans and radish were distributed to SHGs members of Seiyhama village (Batch-II) on 9th Oct. 2023. The seeds were distributed by DMU Support staff and FNGO Team members. During the brief distribution programme, Subject Matter Specialist Agri (NEIDA), Dr. Arensungla Pongen, highlighted the SHGs members on recommended cultivation practices such as field preparation, method of sowing, thinning, irrigation, earthing up, hand weeding, staking and harvesting. In addition, the SHGs were also reminded on the importance of monitoring the progress of the seeds from sowing till the harvest period. Members of Dieze SHG under Seiyhama village started the cultivation of the seeds on 21st Oct. 2023. The seeds were sowed in a demo plot, which were identified by the SHG members.

- * Data collection in the GIS mobile application and minor changes of polygon in the creation data was carried out at Tuophema PEC Plot-1 on 10th Oct. 2023. It was observed that the village community are still maintaining the nursery and the planted trees are 10-15ft tall. The casualty replacements and maintenance work have been carried out by the community.
- * The JFMC members of Seiyhama village (Batch-II) along with Village Council and GBs conducted maintenance work along the PEC area on 13th-14th Oct. 2023.
- * The DMU Support Staffs under DMU Kohima along with PMU Staffs visited Kisama during the Hornbill Festival to carry out a survey of tourists for ecotourism. The survey was an initiative of the PMU and PMC, to determine whether ecotourism was feasible under NFMP. It was also carried out to check if ecotourism would be beneficial for the village community specifically focusing on the NFMP implemented villages.
- * Market linkage under CBBO FPO: Convergence of market linkage with Cluster Based Business Organizations (CBBO) and Farmer Producer Organization (FPO) was carried out on 14th Dec. 2023 at Tseminyu, Gwachonlo and Phenwhenyu village. Through this convergence, the farmers produce are collected from the villages and with the help of the FNGOs, the produce are sold off to various markets. This is done every month in order to assist and help the farmers in their livelihood.
- * Convergence ILP (Phase-2) for Village Seasonal Planning with VLO & SHGs: Convergence for Integrated Livelihood Project (ILP) (Phase-2) for village seasonal planning was carried out from 18th-20th Dec. 2023 with the Village Level Organization and SHGs. The meeting with the VLO and SHGs was conducted to discuss the seasonal planting of various crops and which crops are best suited to be planted within their villages during certain seasons. This was done for timely distribution of various seeds acquired from various agencies or line departments. The meeting was an interactive meeting to get a clear understanding of what crops the farmers and SHGs are interested in so that seeds can be distributed accordingly based on their preference as well to establish which type of crops are best suited to their land and seasons.
