

Officials from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs Japan and JICA mission members visits Tseminyu and Terogvunyu villages:







Officials from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Japan and Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) Mission Members, India visited Tseminyu district on 10th April 2024. On their field visit to Tseminyu Village, the officials visited the Forestry Intervention Model Area in Tseminyu Village which is being implemented under the Nagaland Forest Management Project (NFMP). The Joint Forest Management Committee (JFMC) members apprised the officials on various agricultural practices of the community. Various records and registers maintained by the JFMC were also reviewed by the officials. Speaking during a brief reception programme held in the village, Mr Tokita Yuji, Director of Country Assistance Planning Division II, International Cooperation Bureau, Ministry of Foreign Affairs appreciated the support of the village community for extending their cooperation in the project implementation. He hoped that the project will be further enhanced and implemented in a sustainable way in the future. He further expressed hope that the Japan Government and his team would continue to work in the future in further enhancing the relationship between Japan and India, Japan and Nagaland and Japan and Tseminyu Village. Also speaking during the programme, Mr. Wakamatsu Eiji, Senior Representative, JICA India Office expressed happiness to see that the project is well received by the village and hoped that the project contribute more prosperity to Tseminyu Village. In his brief address to the gathering, Mr. Temjenyabang, IFS, CCF & Project Director (Administration, Finance and Procurement) NFMP expressed delight to see the progress that has been made in the village with the ardent support from the community. 

Farmers Training on Terrace Line Transplanting Conducted at Yachem Village: The training for farmers of Yachem village on Terrace Line Transplantation was conducted at Yachem Village on 7th June 2024 by DMU Longleng and FNGO LEMSACHENLOK in collaboration with Agriculture Department Longleng.

During the training, the farmers were apprised of the various farming techniques in terrace line transplantation and its final output. They were encouraged to avoid the traditional practice of Jhum cultivation and to follow the new and sustainable method of farming.



Inspection/Visits:

Inspection at Tseminyu and Terogyunyu villages: An inspection team led by Shri Supongnukshi IFS, CCF Nagaland visited Tseminyu village (Batch-III) and Terogvunyu village (Batch-II) on 6th April 2024. During the inspection, the team members comprising of Shri Chisayi IFS, DMU Head Kohima, Dr. Sevono Seletsu, ADMU, Shri Yhuntilo Kent, FMU Head Tseminyu inspected the EPA (resting shed) constructed in Tseminyu village. The JFMCs and SHGs members of both the villages were asked to maintain the various records and registers up to date. In this regard, the FNGO Team members were directed to facilitate the JFMCs and SHGs in updating the various records and maintain them in a timely manner. The inspecting officials also visited the sites of Forestry Intervention Models, wherein the JFMC members were instructed to set proper sign board along with details of works being implemented. While inspecting the IGA of Kerhun SHG of Terogyunyu village, the SHG members were encouraged to continue with the activity so that they can continue to generate income

During the interaction in Tuophema village, the JFMC and SHGs members updated on various works carried out under the project. The performance of Shitake mushroom, weaving activity and pig rearing were also discussed with the SHGs members. All the three SHGs has successfully completed their IGA, generated income and have also repaid the loan (Revolving Fund) to the JFMC. The CPD suggested on opening of WhatsApp group comprising of JFMCs, SHG, DMU staff and FNGO team members for smoother coordination. Meanwhile, Shri Dzieselhou Thong, JFMC Chairman Tuophema assured continued support to the Department and NFMP for the welfare of the communities.

In Tseminyu, the visiting team members visited the Range Office constructed under the project. During the interaction with JFMC members of Tseminyu village, Shri Sinlo Semp JFMC Chairman Tseminyu village updated on the status of Entry Point Activities and forestry models adopted in the village under NFMP. The three SHGs of Tseminyu village has submitted their business plan and is yet to receive the Revolving Fund. He further suggested that some of the JFMC members should be trained to build their skills on identifying tree/animal species.

Field Visit by Shri. Shailendra Kumar (PMC Livelihood Expert) on 25th April, 2024: On 25th April, 2024 Shri. Shailendra Kumar (Livelihood Expert) had a discussion with the DMU & ADMU Head and FMU Staff of Mokokchung regarding the

status of the SHGs of Batch-I&II. The meeting was also attended by the FNGOs who gave insightful presentation on the current scenario of the SHGs. He then visited the villages of both FMU Mokokchung (24th April) and FMU Changtongya (25th April) and had a meeting with the respective SHG groups.



Convergence:

Animal Health Service Camp & distribution of pig feeds: An animal health service camp was conducted on 29th June 2024 at NFMP Villages of Tseminyu, Zisunyu, Phenwhenyu, Gwachonlo, Tsosinyu, Ehunnu and Terogvunyu, a collaborative programme with Naga Maiki Small holder Pig Producer Company under convergence with Integrated Livelihood Project (ILP 2). The main motive of this initiative is to provide convenient and timely access to health care products in every village especially for pig health management, provide preventive care services to enable farmers to implement bio-security measures for African Swine Fever (ASF) andraise awareness about General pig health and specifically on ASF.The community mobilizers of the respective villages assisted the Life Stock service provider in conducting the animal service camp. Pig feeds were also provided to village members of Phenwhenyu.
