#### From the Desk:

NFMP received a shot in the arm during the 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter of the calendar year with the visit of Hon'ble Union Minister of State, MOEFCC Shri. Ashwini Kumar Choubey on 20<sup>th</sup> September 2021 to Nagaland. Piphema Old Village Council implementing NFMP had the privilege of hosting the Hon'ble Minister. This quarter witnessed a flurry of activities both in terms of field activities and training. The PMU Office organised 'Capacity Building' Workshops for DMU Support staffs and FNGOs. The training was conducted for preparation of TNA Data Analysis and for preparation of Training modules and training courses. Training on use of web GIS Portal and mobile application were conducted across the districts. Field activities like advance works, plantation activities, and maintenance works were also carried out during the Quarter.

Workshop on Capacity Building

The PMU Office organized a "Capacity Building Workshop" at the Conference Hall, Forest Office Complex, Kohima from 26<sup>th</sup> - 27<sup>th</sup> July 2021 with Shri. PravanjanMohanpatra, Capacity Building Expert PMC as the trainer. The training was conducted to prepare division wise capacity building plan for JFMC Members, SHG members and other stakeholders involved in the implementation of NFMP interventions. During the training, preparation of training modules and finalisation of training courses designs were carried out. DMU support staff and FNGO team leaders from all divisions attended the training session.

It was also conducted for preparation of training modules for JFMC members, SHG members and other stake holders.



Refresher Training on WebGIS Portal and Mobile
Application

A three-day refresher training on use of WEB GIS portal and Mobile Application was held from 8<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> September 2021 at Forest Office Complex, Kohima. On the first day of the training, Shri Rajkumar M., IFS, DFO & DMU Head, Kohima, in his opening remarks said that one has to update themselves with the emerging technologies. He said that unless we update ourselves, we will not be able to catch up with the rest of the world. He suggested the trainers to make the training as simple as possible. Resource persons, GIS Experts, PMC, Mr. Anurag Verma and Dr.LimasanenLongkumer explained about the WebGIS Application, Mobile Application, changes incorporated in the applications and its components. The second day of the training was conducted at Zhadima 'A' village where the participants divided themselves into groups and entered field data using the mobile application. The resource persons also explained the different types of maps and briefed about Participatory Rural Appraisal Exercise. On the concluding day of the training, the uploaded data through Mobile App and storage of data in the server were explained and discussed. Participants from Kohima, Phek, Kiphire and Wokha took part in the three days training.



# Dimapur Division:

Plantation Activities: The plantation activities were carried out at various models in all the five JFMCs (Both Batch I & II) under DMU Dimapur during the month of July 2021.

Refresher Training on Web GIS and Mobile Application: The training was conducted at Forest Office Complex Dimapur from 14<sup>th</sup> -16<sup>th</sup> September 2021 for three divisions i.e. Dimapur, Peren and Mon. The trainees visited Piphema Old Village for hands on training of mobile application and the exercise was conducted at JAF Model after which PRA exercise with the JFMC members of Piphema old Village was conducted.





## **Kiphire Division:**

**Field Visit:** One day field inspection and monitoring supervision was carried out by DMU Head, FMU Head and field staffs at three NFMP villages, namely Old-Risethisi village, Keor village and Bilongkyu village.

The purpose of the inspection visit was to supervise the works done by JFMCs in all these villages. The DMU Head also had meetings with JFMCs members.



#### Kohima Division:

Review meeting with FNGO: The review meeting with FNGO Kohima was held on 14<sup>th</sup> July 2021 at the chamber of DFO, Kohima. During the meeting, Mr. Nagato K. Aye, FNGO team leader apprised the DFO on the appointments of Community Mobilizers for both Batch-I and Batch-II villages. The FNGO team also raised some doubts, which were clarified by the DFO. The DFO also suggested to conduct training on Book - keeping and Accounts for community mobilizers and JFMC members of both Batch – I and Batch – II villages.



SHG profiling at Batch- II villages: SHG profiling was conducted at Phenwhenyu Village, Terogvunyu village on 20<sup>th</sup> July 2021 and Kandinu village, Seiyhama Village on 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2021. FNGO team leader along with supervisors, community mobilizers and DMU support staff entered the data of nine active SHGs using KoBo Collect App. Mr Nagato K. Aye, FNGO team leader highlighted about NFMP and the objective of SHGs profiling. During the interaction, the SHGs members also apprised about the activities being carried out.



The training was organized by PMU and was attended by DMU Staff & FNGO team. The trainees had to prepare a mock business plan with the SHGs of the project villages. The training was facilitated by Shri. Pravanjan Mahopatra, Capacity Building Expert, PMC.



Refresher training on use of WEB GIS Portal and Mobile Application: Three days refresher training on use of WEB GIS Portal and Mobile Application and training on PRA Exercise under NFMP was conducted from 14<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> September, 2021. Dimapur hosted three forest divisions: Dimapur, Peren and Mon for the training along with two FNGO Staffs from each district.

A field visit to Piphema village was also organised on Sept, 15 to monitor different works with the help of a mobile app and GPS.

JFMC Orientation Program at Peletkie & Peren village: JFMC Orientation Program for JFMC & SHG was conducted at Peletkie & Peren village on 20<sup>th</sup> & 21<sup>st</sup> Sept, 2021 respectively. The meeting was organized by FNGO.



#### Phek Division:

Advance Work at Lephori Village: Prior to plantation, Lephori Village under FMU Meluri undertook advance work for Model wise plantation during the 2<sup>nd</sup> Week of July. The activities clearing of bushes and weeds, levelling of soil and removal of obstacles and stacking of bamboo at specific places. A total of around 20 to 30 members undertook the preparation activities.



Model wise Plantation at Kami Village: Batch-I village Kami under FMU Pfutsero undertook plantation activity during the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> week of July. Forestry Intervention and Bio diversity Conservation: Plantation at Lephori Village: Lephori village JFMC undertook Plantation during the last month of August 2021. A total of around 380 members planted around 17780 saplings covering an area of 17 ha under JAF Model. Some of the species include Yongchak and Bogipoma.



**Plantation at Kami Village** - Kami village also undertook Plantation activity during the month of August. Kami JFMC was able to cover around 15 Ha under JAF and JCCCA Model area. Community participation was the key in the plantation activity with almost 80 % of the village population being able to participate in the activity on different days.



PIC Meeting: Prior informed Consent (PIC) meeting for the Batch-III villages under NFMP-JICA project was held on 28<sup>th</sup> September 2021 under FMU Pfutsero. Two villages under Batch-III are Phusachodu and Tsupfume Village. The concerned Batch-III villages thanked the Forest Department and also the DFO during the meeting. DFO Cum DMU Head Shri Thepfuhusie IFS apprised the Village councils on the workings of the NFMP in regards to the overall sustainability of the project, impact of



the project and also its significance on the present and future environmental scenario. He later urged the JFMCs to give their best for the project to be a success and also be a model village for the surrounding villages. The village councils thanked the DFO and also sought guidance from the DMU and FMU in the coming days.


